A Yellow Leaf – these are Silver Birch leaves.



Pebbles shaped like eggs.



Beech nuts. These are the seeds of the Beech tree.



Twigs shaped like letters of the alphabet.



A skeleton leaf- all that is left from the leaf that fell in autumn.



A feather.

- Something heart-shaped
- A leaf that just covers your hand
- Something a bird could use to make a nest
- Something you could use to make a noise
- Something you think is beautiful.

When you have finished your collection, you could use it to make a picture for your own Natural Art Gallery.
