## January 1902

### A hole in one!



Chislehurst Golf Club was established in 1894, and in December of that year won a match against Sidcup by 3 holes.

In the first week of January 1902 there was a report of an amazing incident at the Club. A player ***“in playing a ball from a tee, drove it straight into the side pocket of a gentleman playing his own ball at quite 200 yards off.”***

To corroborate his story, the reporter noted that “this was witnessed by the man’s opponent and the caddies.”
