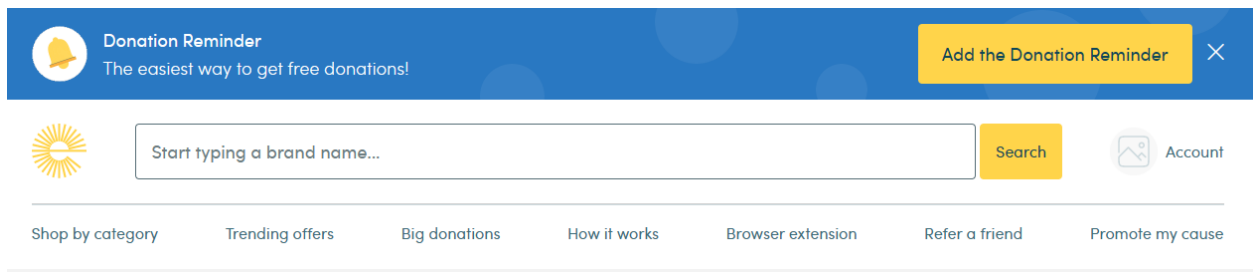
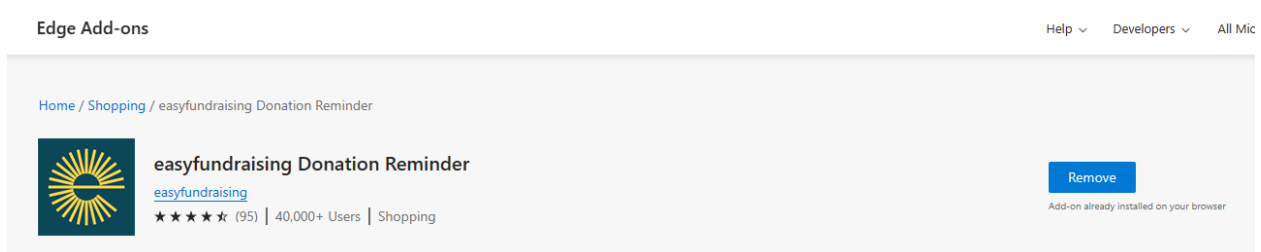


How to Use Easyfundraising.org.uk

- 1) Click on the link to easyfundraising.org.uk (found in our newsletter or website under the DONATIONS tab).
- 2) Choose a cause you care about - Chislehurst and St Paul's Cray Commons is suggested. Please note, you can only select one cause at a time for your donations to be added to, but you can change this as often as you like.
- 3) Sign up to create an account - username (email address) and a new password for this service.
- 4) Accept the offer of a browser extension. If you use more than one browser, then add the browser extension to each one. This is a Donation Reminder. It will pop up on every retailer site where a donation is available which means you don't have to remember to log into easyfundraising first.



If you click on “Add the Donation Reminder” then you will see the following with “Get” instead of “Remove”.



Click on GET, then follow the instructions to pin the reminder on your screen.

Pin for quick access

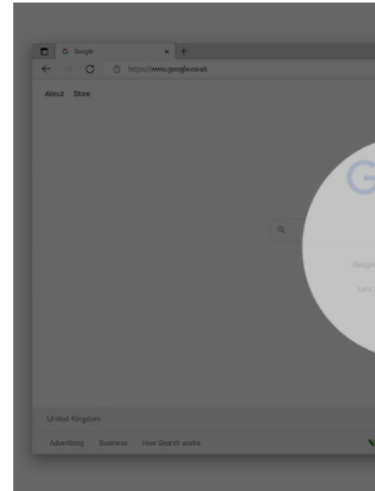
Now you've added the Donation Reminder make sure you pin it so you don't miss out on donations.

After this, whenever you log into the website of a participating retailer, then you don't have to be concerned with logging into easyfundraising.org.uk first. For example, when logging into eBay, you might see this.
